

WELCOME TO THE OLDER TODDLER ROOM

The Older Toddler Room is for the child between the ages of 2 and 2 ½. The staff in the Older Toddler Room are all patient, well educated, CPR and First Aid certified, and the lead teacher has her CDA. Your child's day will be filled with tons of fun learning experiences. We start our day with a 20 minute group time that consists of a good morning song, the alphabet, counting, days of the week, months of the year, and letter recognition. Throughout the week we work on colors and shapes. Sign language is also included in everyday happenings.

After group time has ended, we work on our projects. We do projects that pertain to the letter of the week. Your child will get the opportunity to use a variety of materials such as, paint, markers, glue, and various other art supplies. During project time your child will make their own creations using their imagination and their fine motor skills.

Here at Rosey's, we strive to keep the lines of communication open between the families and the caregivers. When you pick your toddler up in the evening you will always get a verbal description of their day. Posted on the Toddler News Board will be the nap and meal information. A menu of what is being served for breakfast, lunch and snack is posted weekly.

PLEASE BRING IN THE FOLLOWING ITEMS FOR YOUR TODDLER:

FITTED CRIB SHEET for their cot. We ask that you bring anything that makes your child feel comfortable at naptime.

EXTRA CLOTHES for their cubby.

DIAPERS

160 ct. HUGGIES OR PAMPERS WIPES (per month)

FAMILY PICTURE to be displayed in the classroom.

Rosey's provides all cups, bibs and meals. We ask that you not bring your own to avoid confusion.
